

RESIDENTIAL SALES STATISTICS for September 2007

(as published by the Tucson Association of REALTORS® Multiple Listing Service for All Residential Types)

Home Sales Volume in September 2007 was \$190,574,076. That's a 30.3% decrease from the same period last year, and a 31.7 % decrease from last month.

Home Sales Units decreased 36.6% from 1,077 in September 2006 to 683 in September 2007. That's a 33% decrease from August 2007.

Average Sales Price (all residential types included) was \$279,025 last month – that's up by 10% from September 2006 and a 1.9% increase from August 2007.

Median Sales Price was \$215,000 last month – that's a 2.4% increase from September 2006 and down by 2.3% from the previous month, August 2007.

Average Days on Market is up 46% from 50 days in September 2006 to 73 days in September 2007. And, it is up 5.8% from 69 days in August 2007.

Pending Contracts have increased 32.4% from 747 in September 2006 to 989 in September 2007. But this number is down 3.4% from the previous month.

Active Residential Listings decreased 1.2% from 9,297 in September 2006 to 9,190 in September 2007.

New Listings have decreased 14.1% from 2,907 in September 2006 to 2,497 in September 2007. That is a 6.8% increase from the previous month, August 2007.
